The Board will vote to authorize the application for, and (if awarded acceptance of, a grant in the amount of \$500,000 through the Massachusetts Division of Conservation Service's (DCS) Parkland Acquisitions & Renovations for Communities (PARC) Program, for construction expenses associated with the Town Brook Park Trail Improvement Project.
- 9. The Board will vote to accept a grant in the amount of \$56,250 through the U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service's Clean Vessel Act Grant Program, for the purchase of a new pump-out boat which provides free pump-out service for recreational boats in Plymouth Harbor.
- 10. The Board will vote to transfer funds from the Human Resources expenses budget to the Human Resources Salary Budget in the amount of \$3,340.05.
- 11. The Board will vote to transfer funds from the Fire Salary budget to the Fire R & M Vehicles Budget in the amount of \$45,000.
